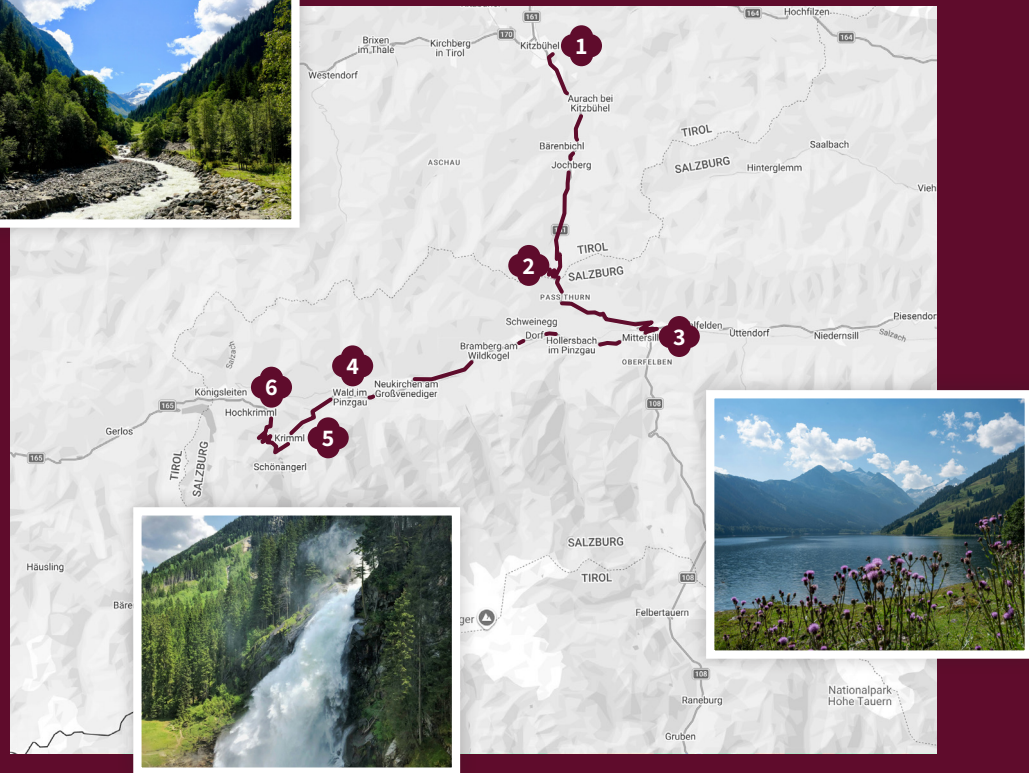
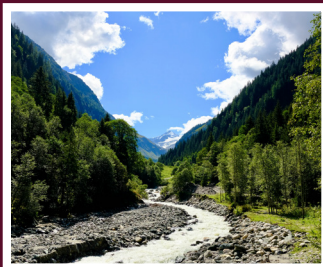


3. THE GERLOS ALPINE ROAD AND THE KRIMML WATERFALLS: THE GRAND PANORAMIC TOUR

This drive is the longest of our three recommendations. It leads over Pass Thurn into the Pinzgau region and on towards Krimml, where the mountain landscape is even vaster, more rugged, and impressive. The Gerlos Alpine Road is a scenic route for anyone who wants to not only drive, but also be constantly amazed along the way: by wide valleys, striking peaks, and views towards the Krimml waterfalls. As this is a longer route, this tour is particularly recommended for guests who carefully plan the timings of their itinerary and only make brief stops.



Character: a long scenic circuit offering Alpine panoramas and impressive far-reaching views

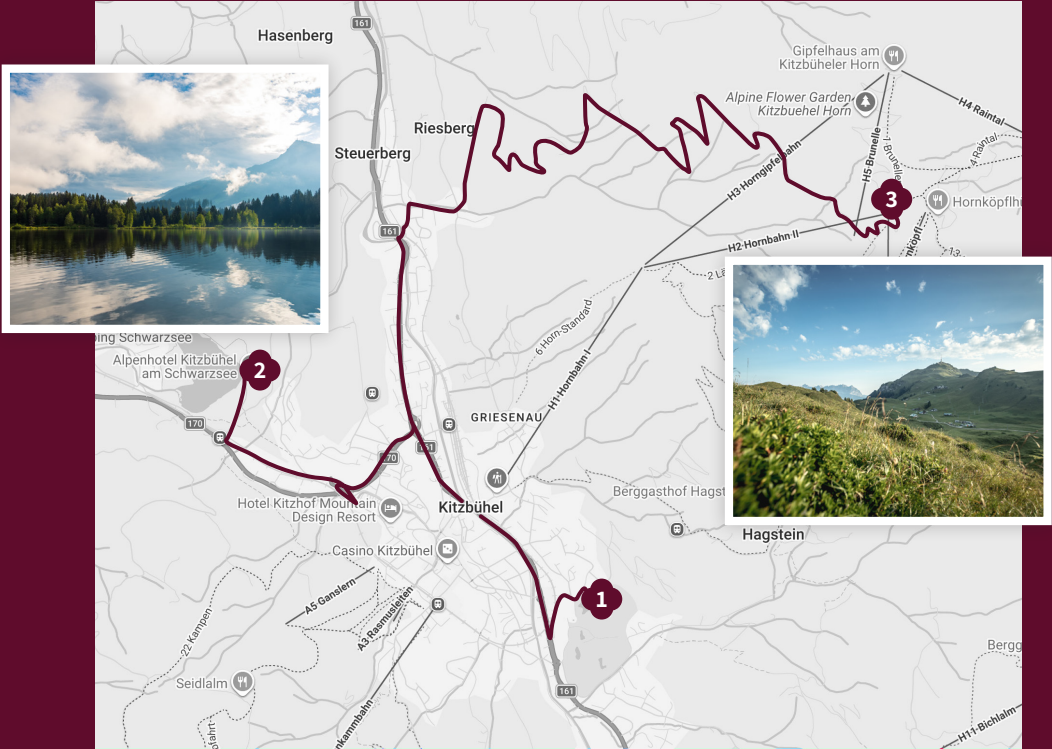


Three tours. Three ways to experience Kitzbühel.

Get in, set off, look up: all around Kitzbühel, just a few bends separate you from some of Tyrol’s most beautiful road experiences. For your test drive, we have selected three routes that are easily accessible from Schlosshotel. Each has its own character – ranging from a short panoramic taster to a longer scenic circuit. The journey times given are for guidance only and may vary depending on traffic, weather, and any stops you make. There are also numerous other worthwhile routes and destinations in the Kitzbühel area. Please feel free to ask us; we’ll be happy to recommend the right tour for you.

Please note: The vehicles will be available during the agreed time slot. Test drives can be conveniently booked in advance or – subject to current availability – spontaneously at the reception. Please ensure you carry your valid driving licence with you throughout the drive and comply with the agreed terms and conditions of use. We kindly ask you to return the vehicle with a full fuel tank. Smoking is not permitted in the vehicle. Please make sure you allow plenty of time for a relaxed, unrushed drive back to the hotel. The next explorer is already looking forward to their experience.

Three tour recommendations



1. SUMMIT PANORAMA ON MT KITZBÜHELER HORN: SHORT, STEEP, AND IMPRESSIVE

This tour is ideal if you want to get a real feel for Kitzbühel in a short space of time. From Schlosshotel, the route leads up towards Mt Kitzbüheler Horn – with a first glimpse of Lake Schwarzsee if you wish. After just a few kilometres, the landscape opens up, the road takes on a more Alpine character, and the view expands. Once you reach the top, the panorama invites you to pause for a moment: Kitzbühel from a bird’s eye view, framed by grassy hills, rocky peaks, and the sky. You can see all the way to the Hohe Tauern National Park.



Character: compact panoramic tour with stunning views and Alpine road conditions



Please note: there is a toll on the panoramic road. The fee is paid directly at the pay machine at the barrier. The panoramic road is open to traffic subject to weather conditions and seasonal variations. Please check at the reception before you set off.



Navigation: Schlosshotel Kitzbühel, Lake Schwarzsee Kitzbühel, Alpenhaus on Mt Kitzbüheler Horn, Schlosshotel Kitzbühel



2. PASS THURN TOUR: FLOWING BENDS, SWEEPING VIEWS, AND ALPINE EASE

This route is an excellent choice if you want to experience the car on a well-maintained country road. From Kitzbühel, the route climbs steadily via Aurach and Jochberg, passing through forests and past farmsteads, with unobstructed views of the Kitzbühel Alps. Pass Thurn links Tyrol with the Salzburg region and offers precisely that blend of peace, bends, and scenery along the way that makes for a pleasantly easy drive, with the Hohe Tauern National Park providing a stunning panorama on the horizon. In Mittersill, you can easily turn around and then drive back to Kitzbühel along the same route.



Character: a classic mountain-pass drive with a good rhythm, fantastic bends, and sweeping views



Please note: the route follows public roads. Traffic, weather conditions, and roadworks may affect your journey time.
